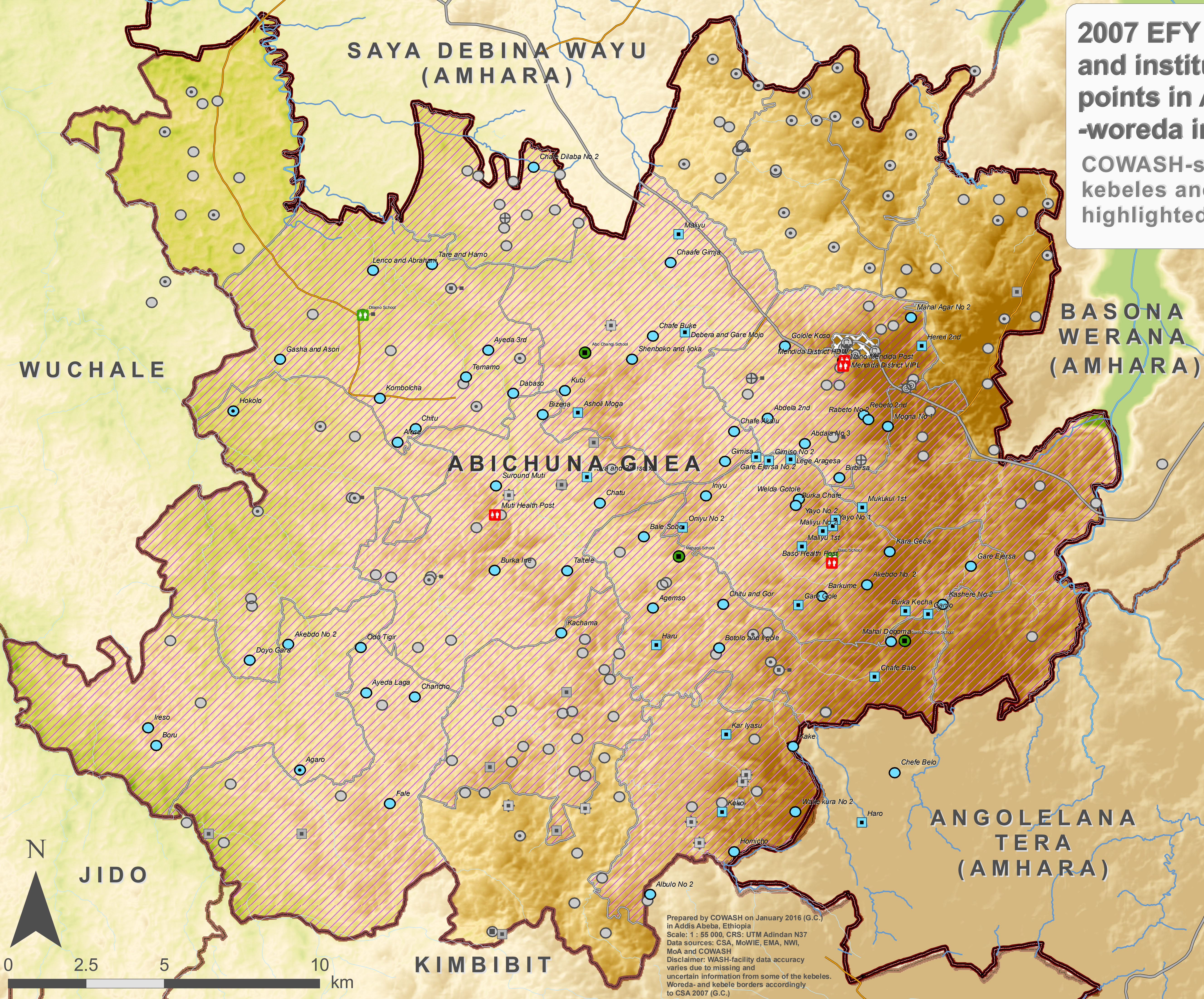


2007 EFY communal and institutional water points in Abichuna Gnea -woreda in Oromia

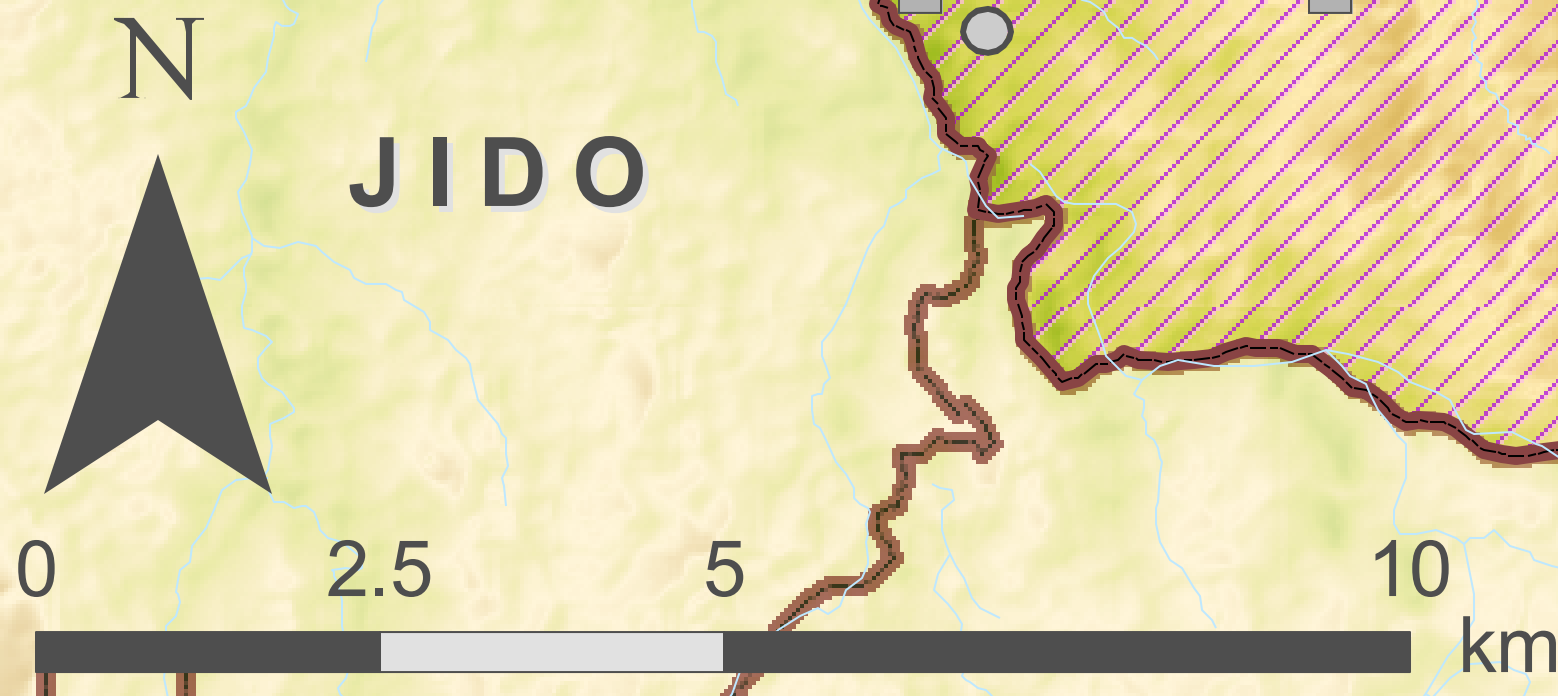
