Background of WRDF

Establishment & Mission

- Established in 2002 by proclamation no.268/2002
- To provide long-term loan to TWUs & IWUAs, ranging from 15 to 30 years
- The repaid amount will be accumulated as revolving fund

No. of towns by Region

- WRDF provided loan for 114 projects in 104 towns
- A total of 10 billion birr allocated & provided for loan
- Regional distribution of towns:
 - Oromiya..... 44 towns/48 projects
 - SNNP..... 30 towns/32 projects
 - Amhara..... 15 town/projects
 - Tigray..... 7 towns/9 projects
 - Benishangul..... 2 towns/projects
 - Somali..... 2 towns/projects
 - Gambella..... 1 towns/project
 - Harari..... 1 towns/project
 - Diredawa..... 1 towns/project
 - Addis Ababa..... 1 towns/project

Challenges Encountered

- WRDF can not satisfy loan request demand from towns due to drastic increase.
- Prolonged loan repayment period
- Negligible interest rate on loan
- No additional revenue other than the repaid loan
- Weak capacity of borrower TWUs
- Equity Vs viability of Projects
- Non responsiveness of Regions (timeliness, etc.)
